


Vocational Professionals Admission Scheme(VPAS)

The Vocational Professionals Admission Scheme (VPAS) is an initiative promulgated by the HKSAR Government, aiming to attract non-local students to remain in Hong Kong upon graduation to work in a skilled trade relevant to their programmes of study. The VPAS will run as a pilot programme for two years, aiming to attract non-local students (including those from Mainland China and other countries/regions1) to enrol in VPAS eligible VTC full-time Higher Diploma (2-year) programmes and remain in Hong Kong for employment in the skilled trades relevant to their programmes of study, leveraging their acquired expertise to contribute to crucial industries as technical professionals or specialists.

- 1 Non-local students enrolled in the VPAS eligible VTC full-time Higher Diploma (2-year) programmes can apply for the "Vocational Professionals Admission Scheme (VPAS)" upon graduation. However, applicants must reach the age of 18 or above when they submit their VPAS applications. This Scheme is not applicable to nationals of Afghanistan, Cuba, Laos, Democratic People's Republic of Korea, Nepal and Vietnam.
- 2 Non-local students must complete the VPAS eligible VTC full-time Higher Diploma (2-year) programmes within a maximum study period of three years to be eligible for VPAS application.
- 3 In the 2024/25 academic year, the VPAS covers 27 eligible programmes in 5 skilled trades. An addition of 7 eligible programmes covering 7 more skilled trades will be included in the 2025/26 academic year. Please visit the VTC website for more details.



- 4 Under the prevailing immigration policy, non-local students enrolled in the VPAS eligible VTC full-time Higher Diploma (2-year) programmes are not eligible to apply for their dependants to remain in Hong Kong.
- Non-local students enrolled in the VPAS eligible VTC full-time Higher Diploma (2-year) programmes can apply to remain in/return to and take up employment in Hong Kong under the VPAS between 7-12 months after graduation. They must secure a job relevant to their programmes of study with a remuneration package at the market level and that the contract of the eligible employment should at least be one year.
 - ii. Persons admitted to remain in/return to and take up employment in Hong Kong under the VPAS may apply to bring their spouse and unmarried dependent children under the age of 18 to Hong Kong under the prevailing dependant policy at the time of application. They are eligible to work and study in Hong Kong during their period of stay.
- iii. For details regarding the VPAS application, please refer to the "Guidebook for Vocational Professionals Admission Scheme" issued by the Immigration Department (please refer to the Immigration Department's website for the "Guidebook for Vocational Professionals Admission Scheme" to be issued).
- 6 Applicants must have ordinarily resided in Hong Kong for a continuous period of not less than seven years in accordance with the Immigration Ordinance and fulfill other relevant requirements

General Entrance Requirements*:

Applicants having completed senior secondary education with recognised examination results, or equivalent in their home countries. For example, holders of GCE A-level, GCSE, IGCSE, IB Diploma, etc. will be considered for admission.

OF

Applicants possessing post-secondary education qualifications, such as college diploma, associate degree, professional diploma, university degree, etc.

OR

Substantial work experience and/or prior qualification(s) obtained in or outside Hong Kong relevant to the Higher Diploma Programme applying with demonstrated ability to undertake sub-degree education.

- AND -

Recognised English Language Qualification (e.g. TOEFL, IELTS, GCSE/IGCSE/GCE English Language, IB English Language, SAT, etc.) or Pass an English assessment administered by VTC; and

Applicants would be evaluated on their Chinese proficiency during their application. Certain Higher Diploma programmes, e.g. programmes with Chinese (Putonghua or Cantonese) as the Medium of Instruction, will require a higher level of Chinese proficiency.

- * TOEFL iBT Home Edition, IELTS Online, and IELTS Indicator test results will not be considered.
- * Students who apply with Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD) qualification must present proof of place of residence. Applicants who obtain OSSD qualification through online or distance learning would not be considered.

Higher Diploma Programmes

Tuition fee: HK\$67,000 (US\$8,590) per year (Business Discipline) or HK\$68,800 (US\$8,821) (other Disciplines)

Fees

Registration & Student Service Fees: Total HK\$7,000 (US\$898) (payable upon acceptance of offer, in which the Registration Fee of HK\$5,000 (US\$642) will be deducted from the first installment of tuition fees)

Other Fees include the application fee of HK\$500 (US\$65), caution money and Students' Union Fees, etc.

Note:

- Tuition fees are subject to annual review. All fees must be paid in Hong Kong Dollars, and all bank transfer related charges shall be borne by the student.
- The tuition fee for the 2026/27 academic year is approximately HK\$75,400 (US\$9,667) per year (Business Disciplines) or HK\$77,400 (US\$9,924) (other Disciplines). The tuition fees are for reference only, and are subject to annual review.
- The above fee information is converted at a rate of US\$1 = HK\$7.8 for reference only.
