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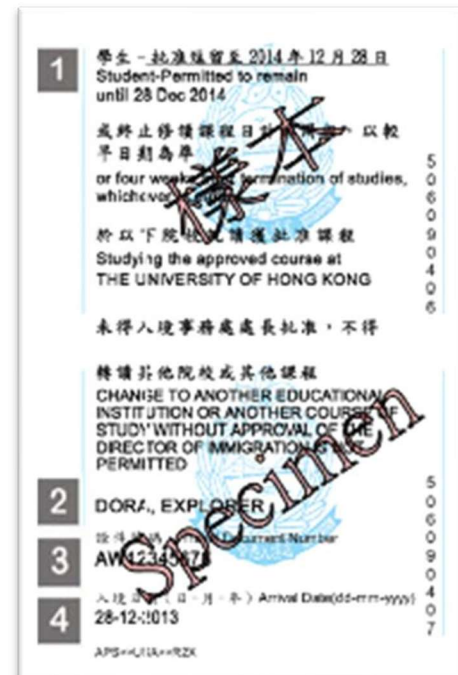
1. On the Day of Arrival

1.1 Visa Activation

Non-local students will be issued a landing slip on arrival to activate the student visa when clearing immigration (sample of landing slip on the right). The landing slip bears your English name, travel document number, arrival date and your conditions and limit of stay in Hong Kong. **You must keep the landing slip safe while you remain in Hong Kong. You must show the landing slip to institute staff during registration to demonstrate that your visa has been activated. Otherwise, you will not be allowed to attend classes.**

The landing slip is issued upon each arrival. No slip will be issued or your travel documents stamped for departure (with occasional exceptions for stamping of documents).

Those who require a replacement landing slip may apply free of charge at the Other Visas and Permits Section, Immigration Department, 5/F, Administration Tower, Immigration Headquarters, 61 Po Yap Road, Tseung Kwan O, New Territories.



1.2 Travel to Hong Kong, Kowloon and the New Territories

If you intend to travel directly to VTC accommodation, please skip ahead to part 1.3 (for Pok Fu Lam Hall) or part 1.4 (for Tsing Yi Hall). To reach other parts of Hong Kong, see information immediately below.

Hong Kong is well-served by public transport. On arrival, you will be able to connect to your accommodation via taxi by following signs at the airport or MTR station.

1.3 Travel to the VTC Halls of Residence (Pok Fu Lam) (hereafter called “PFL Hall”)

1.3.1 To the PFL Hall by Taxi

Taxi is the most direct way to travel to the PFL Hall from the airport. The travelling times and costs are as follows:

FROM	Travel Time (mins)	Approximate Cost (HKD)

1.4 Travel to the VTC Halls of Residence (Tsing Yi) (hereafter called “TY Hall”)

1.4.1 To the TY Hall by Taxi

Taxi is the most direct option to travel to the TY Hall from the Airport. The travelling times and costs are as follows:

2. VTC Halls of Residence

2.1 PFL Hall

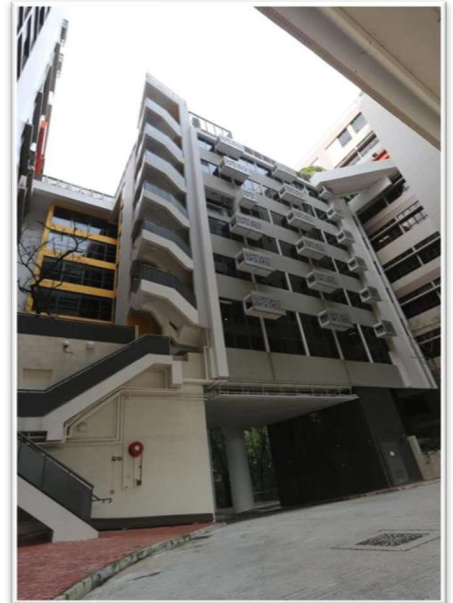
Each room has curtains and each resident is provided with a single bed with mattress, desk with drawers, wardrobe with drawers, a chair and a rubbish bin.

Free telephone facilities are in each room (local calls only) and free Internet access is available (cabled and wireless).

The following items **are NOT provided**:

Network cable, bed sheets, duvet, duvet cover, pillows and pillowcases, as well as all personal items; towel, soap, shower gel, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, mugs, glasses, slippers etc.

You can buy these items at the nearby supermarkets or homeware stores. These can be found at the Chi Fu Landmark shopping arcade, a 10-minute walk from the Hall.

2.2 TY Hall

Rooms have window blinds and each resident is provided with a single bed with mattress, under-bed storage drawer, wardrobe, desk with drawers, a chair and a rubbish bin.

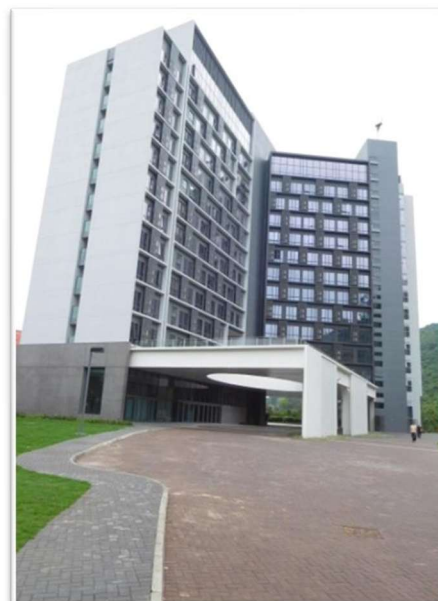
Free cable and wireless Internet access is available.

Network cable, bed sheets, duvet, duvet cover, pillows and pillowcases, as well as all personal items; towel, soap, shower gel, shampoo, toothpaste, toothbrush, mugs, glasses, slippers etc.

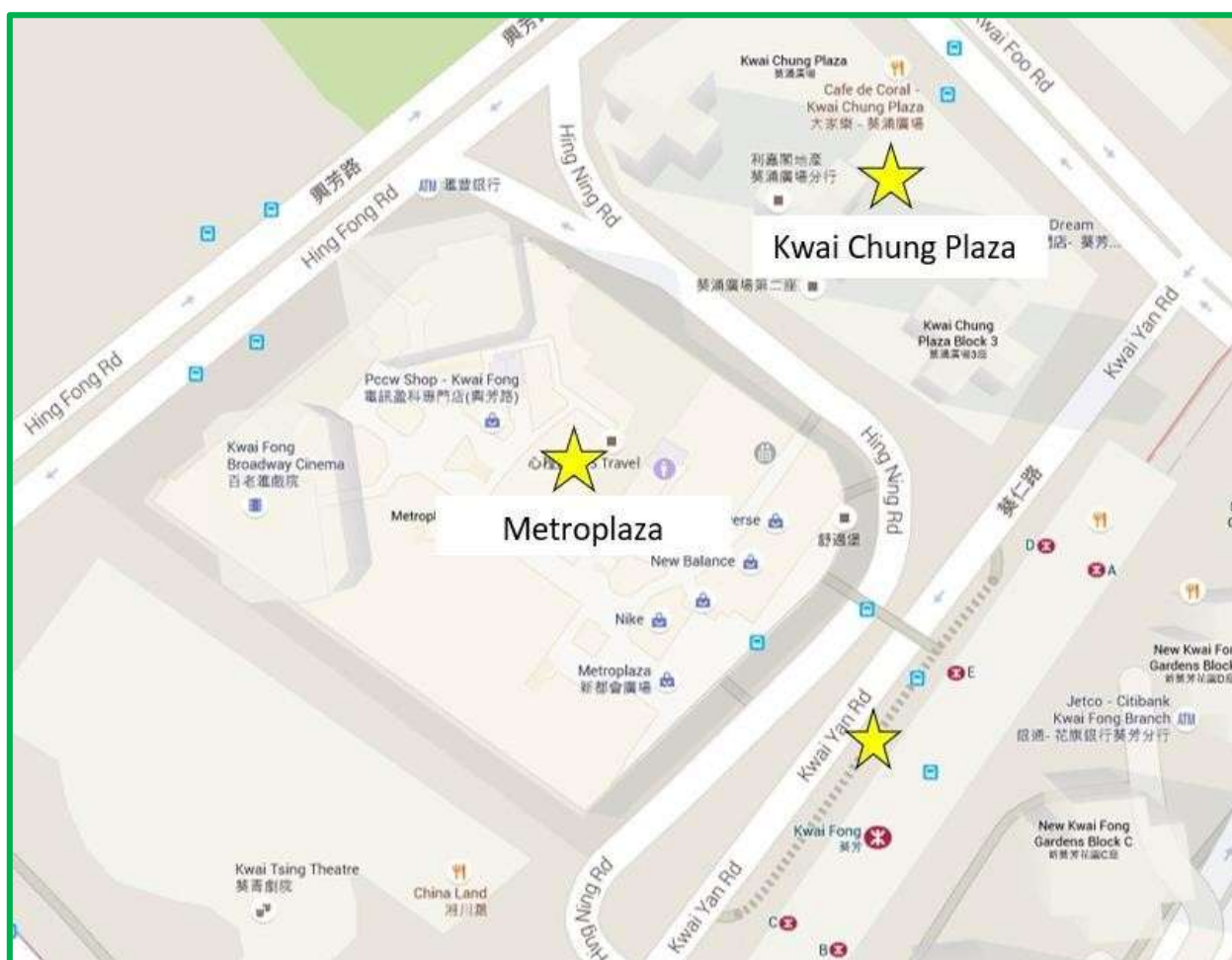
You can buy personal items at Wellcome supermarket or 759 Store in Mayfair Gardens, a 10-minute walk from the dormitory.

Larger items such as a duvet, pillow and bedding can be purchased at shops within Metroplaza or at some of the shops within Kwai Chung Plaza. MTR Kwai Fong Station, Metroplaza and Kwai Chung Plaza are all interconnected (see part 4.2 for directions to MTR Kwai Fong Station).

4. Travel to Campuses

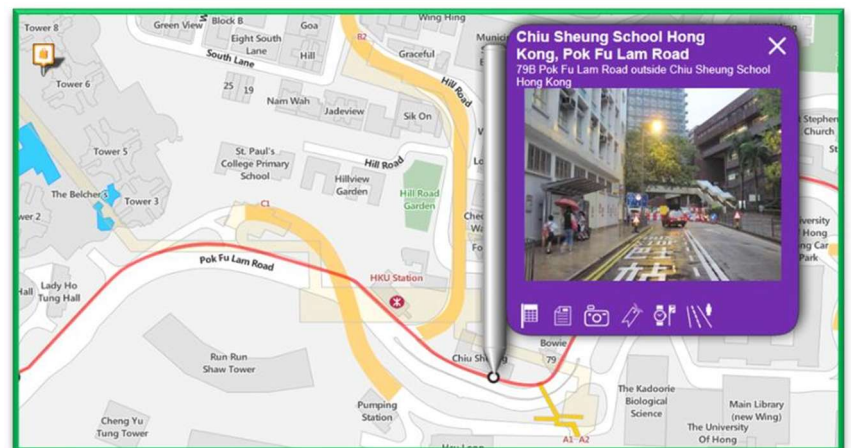
4.1 From the PFL Hall to MTR Station

Take a bus (No. 40) or Green Minibus (No. 22, 22S, 31) from the stop outside the Shine Skills Centre to MTR HKU (Hong Kong University) Station.



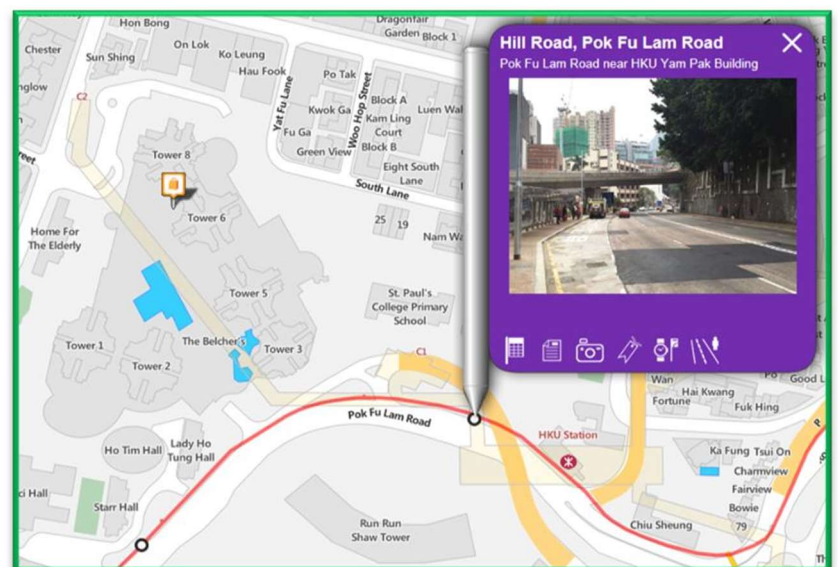
Bus (no. 40M)

Get off at “Chiu Sheung School Hong Kong, Pok Fu Lam Road” and look for the signs pointing to the MTR station. Take the MTR to the nearest station to your campus.



Green Minibus (no. 22, 22S or 31)

Get off at “Hill Road, Pok Fu Lam Road” and look for the signs pointing to the MTR station. Then take the MTR to the nearest station to your campus.



4.2 From the TY Hall to MTR Station

Walk from TY Hall to Mayfair Gardens. Take Mini Bus 88C from Mayfair Gardens and get off at the last stop, outside MTR Kwai Fong Station. Then take the MTR to the nearest station to your campus.



4.3 From MTR Station to HKDI & IVE (Lee Wai Lee)



Address:

3 King Ling Road, Tseung Kwan O, New Territories

Take the MTR Tseung Kwan O Line (purple) to Tiu Keng Leng Station and take exit A2. The campus is located opposite the station.



4.4 From MTR Station to IVE (Chai Wan)



Address:

30 Shing Tai Road, Chai Wan, Hong Kong

Take the MTR Island Line (blue) to Heng Fa Chuen Station and take exit A2. Make a U-turn and take the stairs up to the podium. Walk through the podium to Chai Wan Shing Tai Road. Walk 10 minutes along the road to the campus.



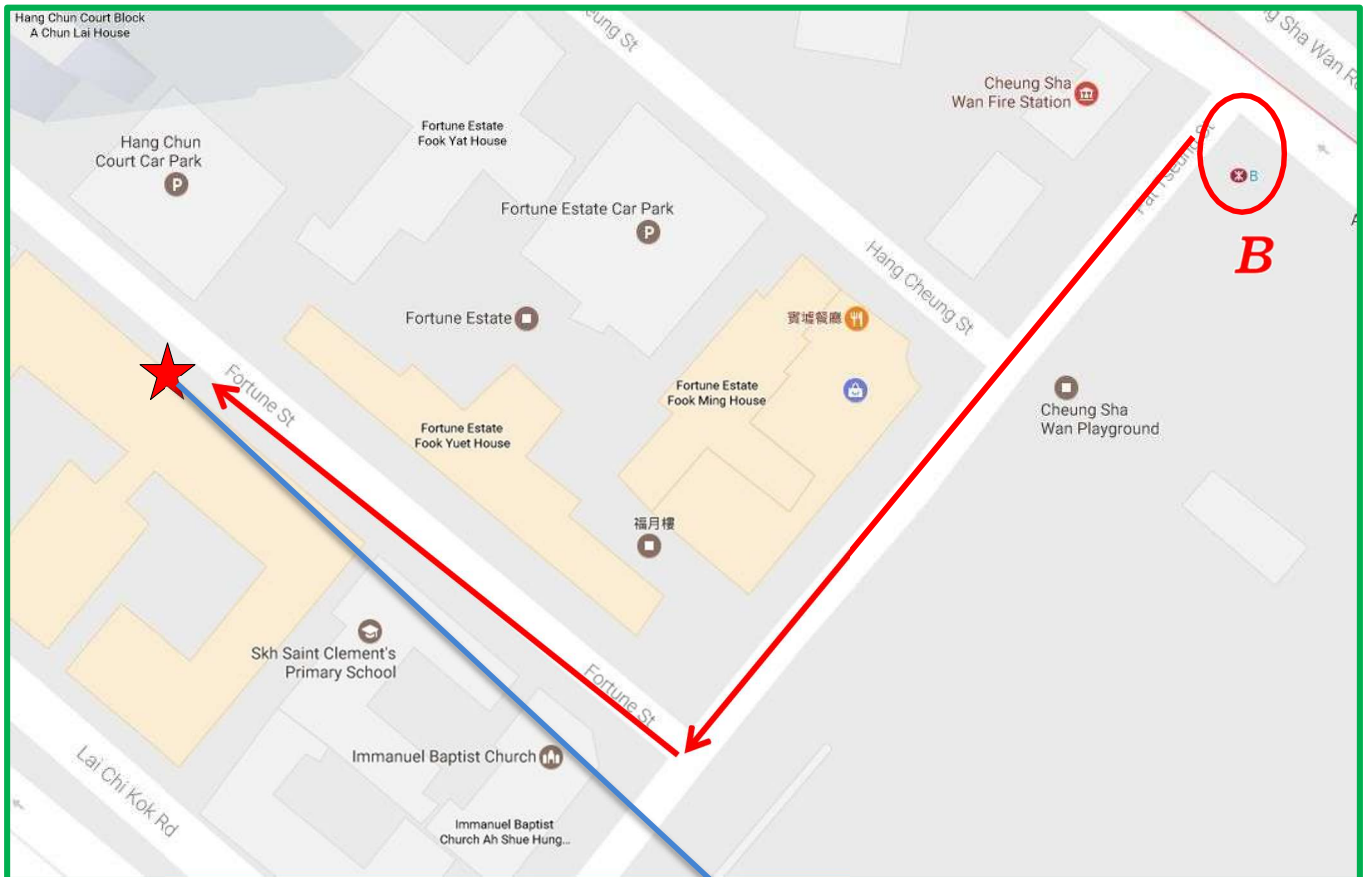
4.5 From MTR Station to IVE (Haking Wong)



Address:

702 Lai Chi Kok Road, Cheung Sha Wan, Kowloon

Take the MTR Tsuen Wan Line (red) to Cheung Sha Wan Station and take exit B. Go straight on along Fat Chong Street then turn right onto Fortune Street and walk to the campus entrance.



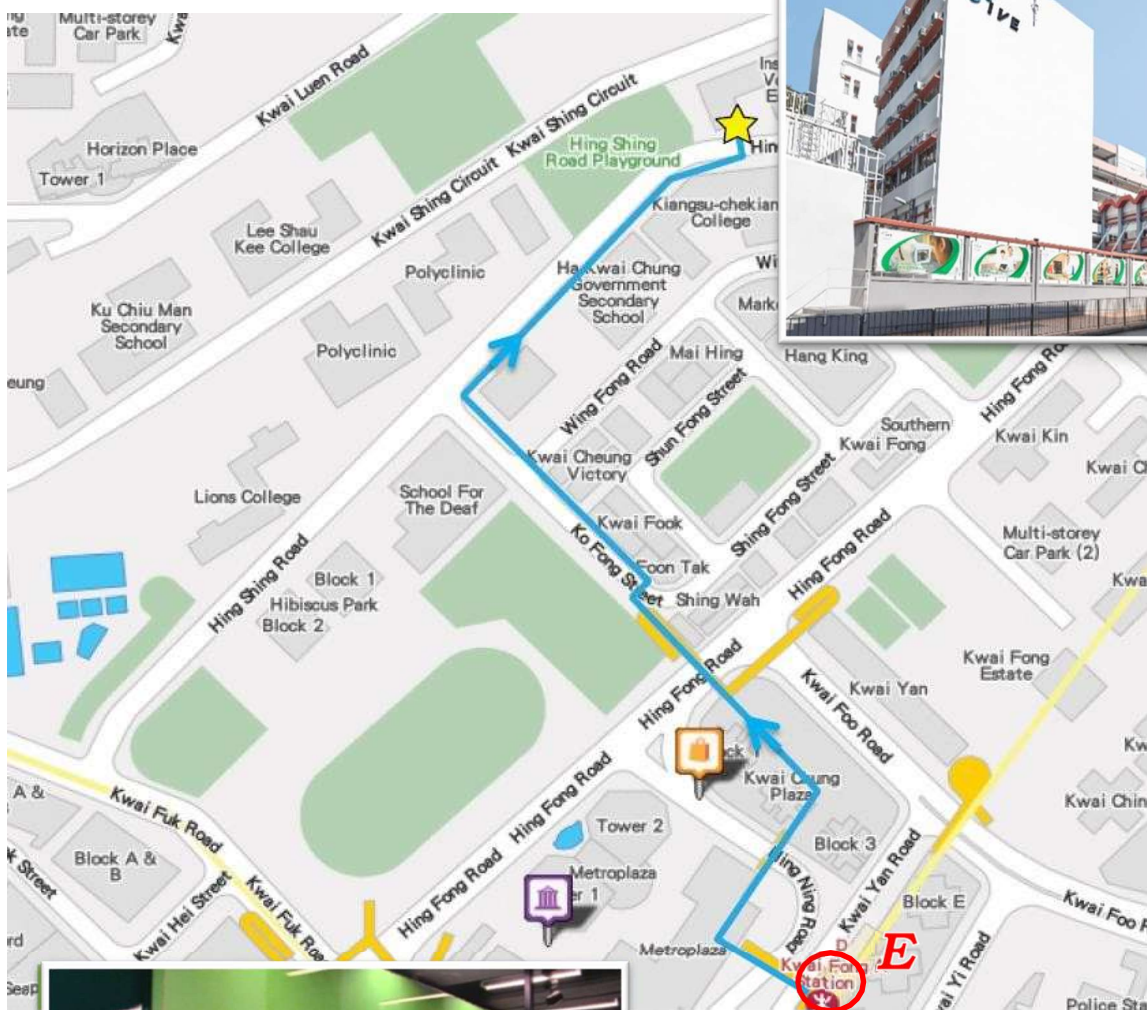
4.6 From MTR Station to IVE (Kwai Chung)



Address:

20 Hing Shing Road, Kwai Chung, New Territories

Take the MTR Tsuen Wan Line (red) to Kwai Fong Station and take exit E on the platform level. Walk into Metroplaza and take the first right turn to the 2/F of Kwai Chung Plaza. Pass through the plaza to the exit at the other end at Ko Fong Street exit, use the bypass to get back to ground level. Walk along Ko Fong Street and turn right at Hing Shing Road, then walk straight ahead.



4.7 From MTR Station to IVE (Kwun Tong)

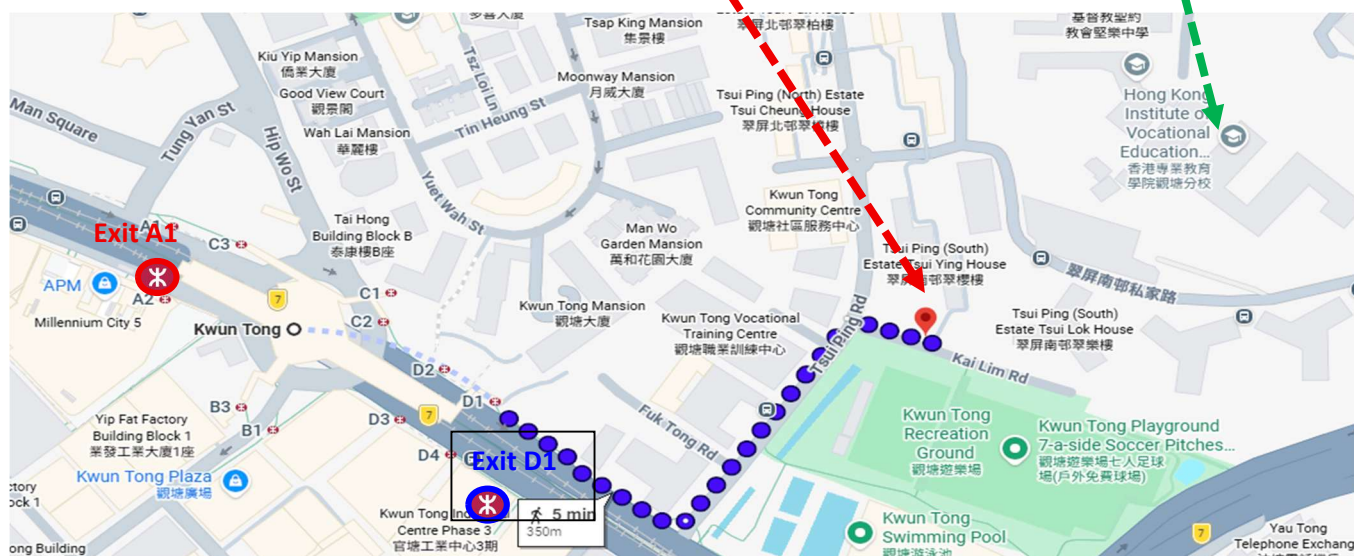

25 Hiu Ming Street, Kwun Tong, Kowloon

Take the MTR Kwun Tong Line (green) to Kwun Tong Station and take exit A1. The easiest way to reach the campus initially is to hail a red taxi. This will take around 10 minutes and the estimated cost is HK\$50.

When you become familiar with the area, You can take the red minibus to school. The red minibus only provides services at specific times. It departs from outside Tsui Ying House, Tsui Ping South Estate, Kai Lim Road (about a 5-minute walk from Exit D1 of Kwun Tong Station, opposite the astroturf football pitch of Kwun Tong Recreation Ground), and gets off outside the school gate. The minibus accepts payment in Octopus or small changes (HKD 4). We suggest you ask a local student to show you the details first.



You may also take a 15-20 mins walk to the campus from exit D1 of Kwun Tong station.

4.8 From MTR Station to IVE (Morrison Hill)

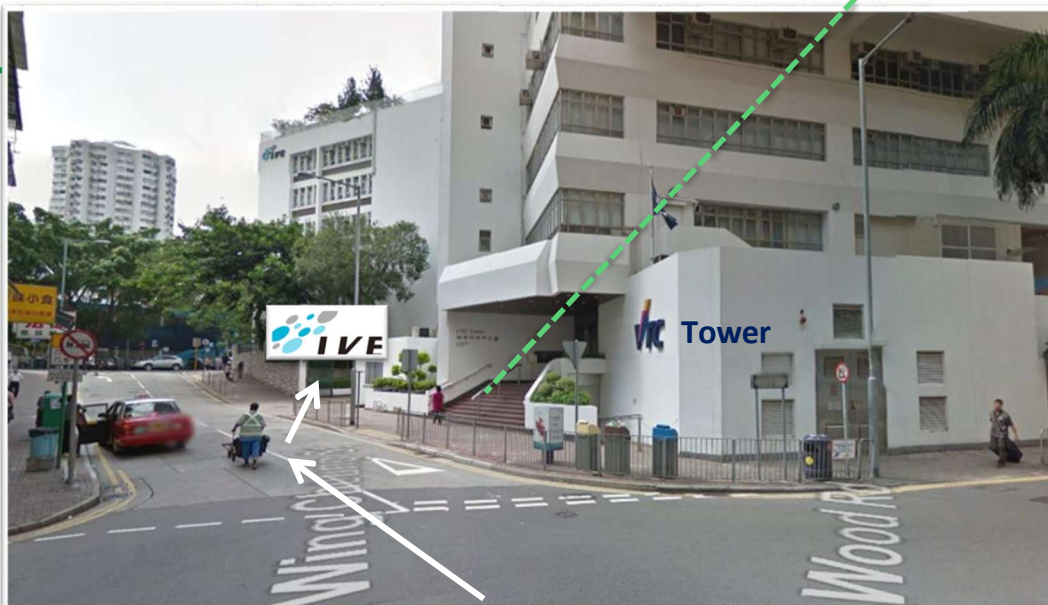

IVE (Morrison Hill), where some HKDI classes are held, is adjacent to VTC Tower and opposite Morrison Hill Swimming Pool. Follow the directions to VTC Tower and you will see the campus on your right as you walk along Wing Cheung Street.

Directions from MTR Wanchai Station to the VTC Tower (27 Wood Road, Wanchai)

Exit at **A3**-exit of the Wanchai station

- (cross the road once you get to the street level [with traffic light]) Turn left & walk along Johnston Road
- Keep to your right and stay on Wan Chai Road
- Turn right on Heard Street
- Cross the 3-way junction of Cross Lane, Wing Cheung Street and Wood Road (no traffic light) – *Please be very careful!*
- **Reach the VTC Tower** (corner of Wood Road and Wing Cheung Street)



Note: Mainland and International Affairs Office is located on 14/F of VTC Tower.

4.9 From MTR Station to IVE (Sha Tin)



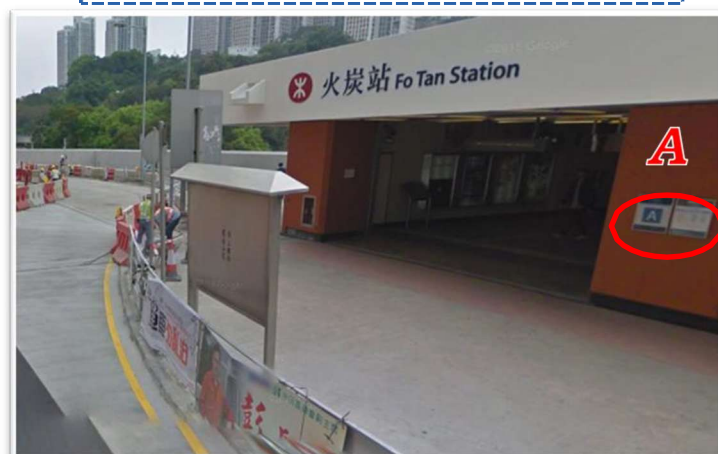
Take the MTR East rail line (light blue) to Fo Tan Station.

- 1) Take exit A and turn right towards the roundabout and over the bridge.

- 2) Follow the pedestrian walkway and take the subway/underpass.

- 3) Turn left under Fo Tan Road.

- 4) Turn right to enter the campus.

The walk should take 7-8 minutes.



4.10 From MTR Station to IVE (Tsing Yi)



Address:

20 Tsing Yi Road, Tsing Yi Island, New Territories

Take the MTR to Kwai Fong Station and turn right at Exit C. You will find the Green Minibus Station there. Follow transportation outlined in part 1.4.3 (directions to the TY Hall). Enter IVE(TY) campus when you get off minibus 88C.

4.11 From MTR Station to IVE (Tuen Mun)



Address:

18 Tsing Wun Road, Tuen Mun, New Territories

Take the MTR West Rail Line (brown) to Tuen Mun Station. Take exit A and turn Left towards Pui To Road. Walk along Pui To Road and turn left at Tsing Wun Road. You will see the bridge on your right as you walk along Tsing Wun Road. Cross the bridge and turn left towards Tsing Wun Road. Walk along Tsing Wun Road and turn right to enter the campus..

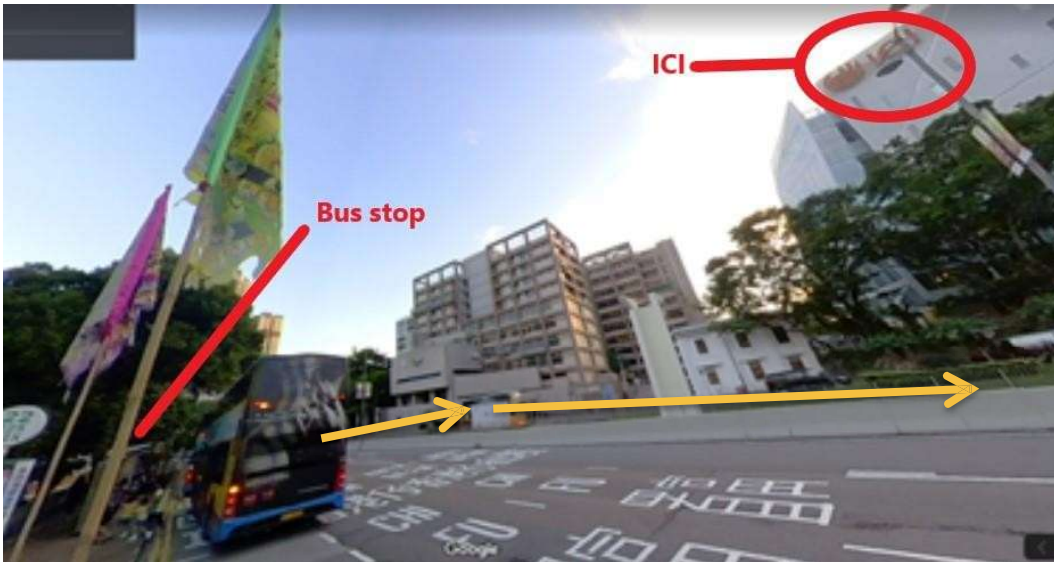


4.12 From MTR Station to ICI (Pokfulam)



Address:
143 Pokfulam Road, Hong Kong

Take the MTR Island Line (blue) to HKU Station. Then take bus route no. 4, 4X, 30X, 37A, 40 or 970 at the stop outside Exit A1. Get off at “Pok Fu Lam Village”. ICI is located right opposite the bus stop. Just cross the road by the traffic light ahead of the bus station and walk to the campus.
